

- Soon: Green Paper on Urban Transport


EU Action Plan for Energy Efficiency: realising the full saving potential

EU EE Action Plan: 10 priorities, over 100 policy measures

 Priority N°1: Appliances & equipment energy labelling & minimum standards, a systematic & dynamic process

EU EE Action Plan, priority n°2: Making Buildings more energy efficient

- Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD) is implemented in several EU Countries.
- Requirements for new buildings should be strengthened by regular steps.
- Rehabilitation of existing buildings also concerned. This is a big challenge!
- The Certificate of Energy Performance will help making differences in the market for sales & rent

Priority n°3: Making power generation & distribution more efficient

- Minimum efficiency requirements for capacity < 20 MW in 2008 (electricity, heating, cooling)
- Guidelines for efficient operation & regulatory framework, to reduce losses
- Facilitating & promoting cogeneration and district heating (also district cooling, wherever appropriate)

Moving on Transport : fuel efficient cars & modal shift to public & cleaner modes





- Priority n°4: fuel efficient cars
- Target 2012: 120gCO2/km for new cars
- Energy label for cars
- Encouraging Public transport, car sharing, non motorised modes
- EUC proposes relating vehicle taxation to CO2 emission

Financing energy efficiency, economic incentives, & energy pricing

- Removing last barriers to Energy Services Companies
- Promoting shared & guaranteed savings, 3rd party financing, performance contracts
- Especially for SMEs
- Mobilising the Financing institutions
- Including EU-Structural & Cohesion funds,
- As Priority n°6 is co financing EE in New Member States.
- Priority n°7: a coherent use of taxation, integrating EE & environmental aspects

- Priority n°8:Raising Energy Efficiency awareness
- Public Institutions should be exemplary
- Environment Programme for SMEs, including Energy Efficiency toolkit
- Energy Efficient School National Awards
