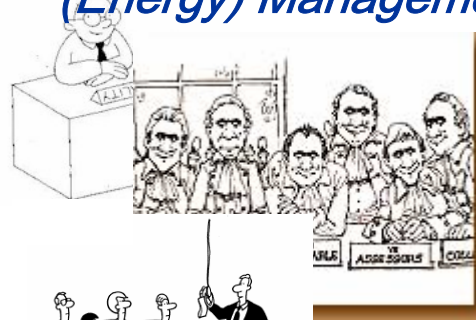

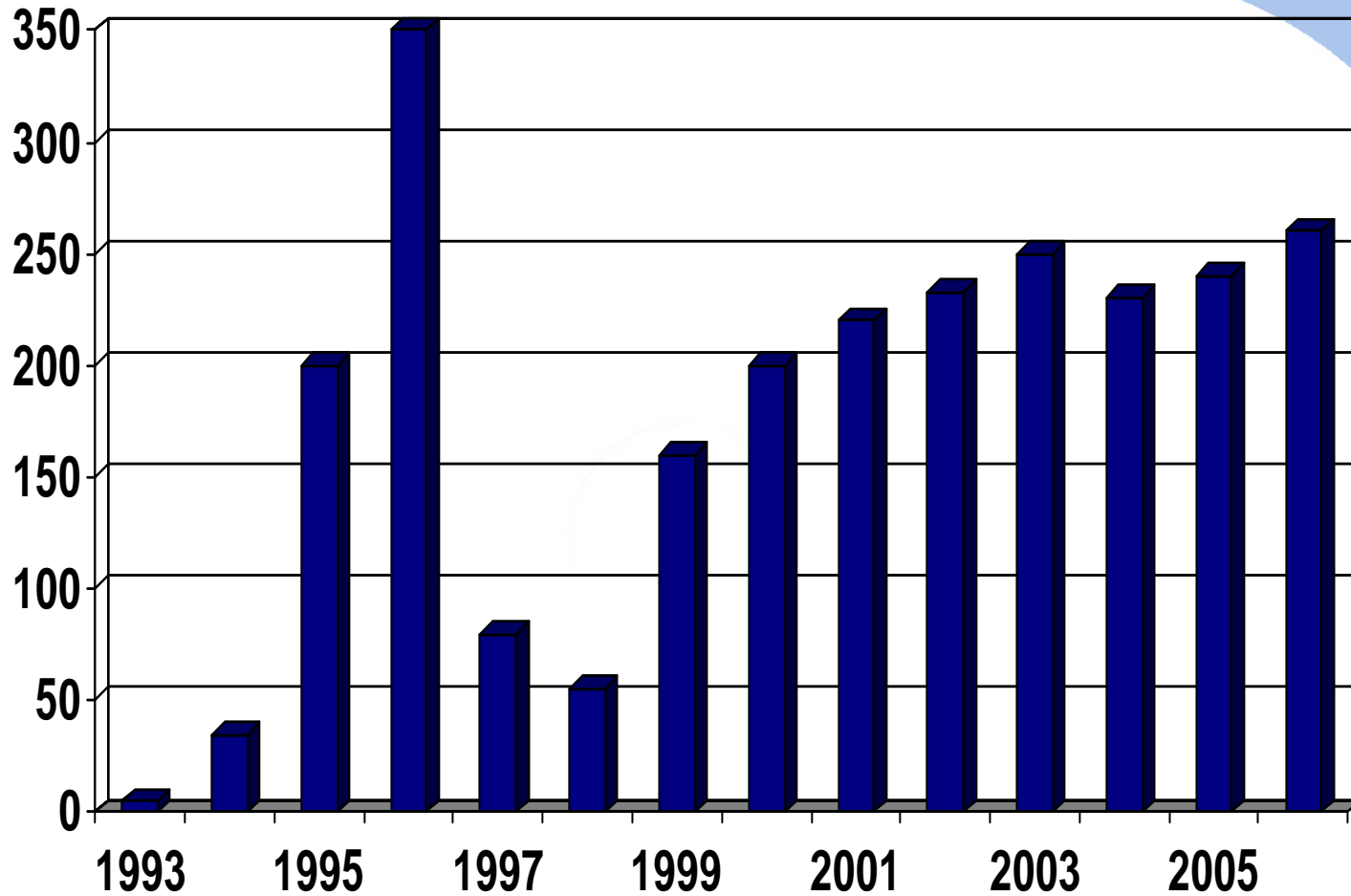


EPS - Energy Potential Scan

 - ‘aftercare’

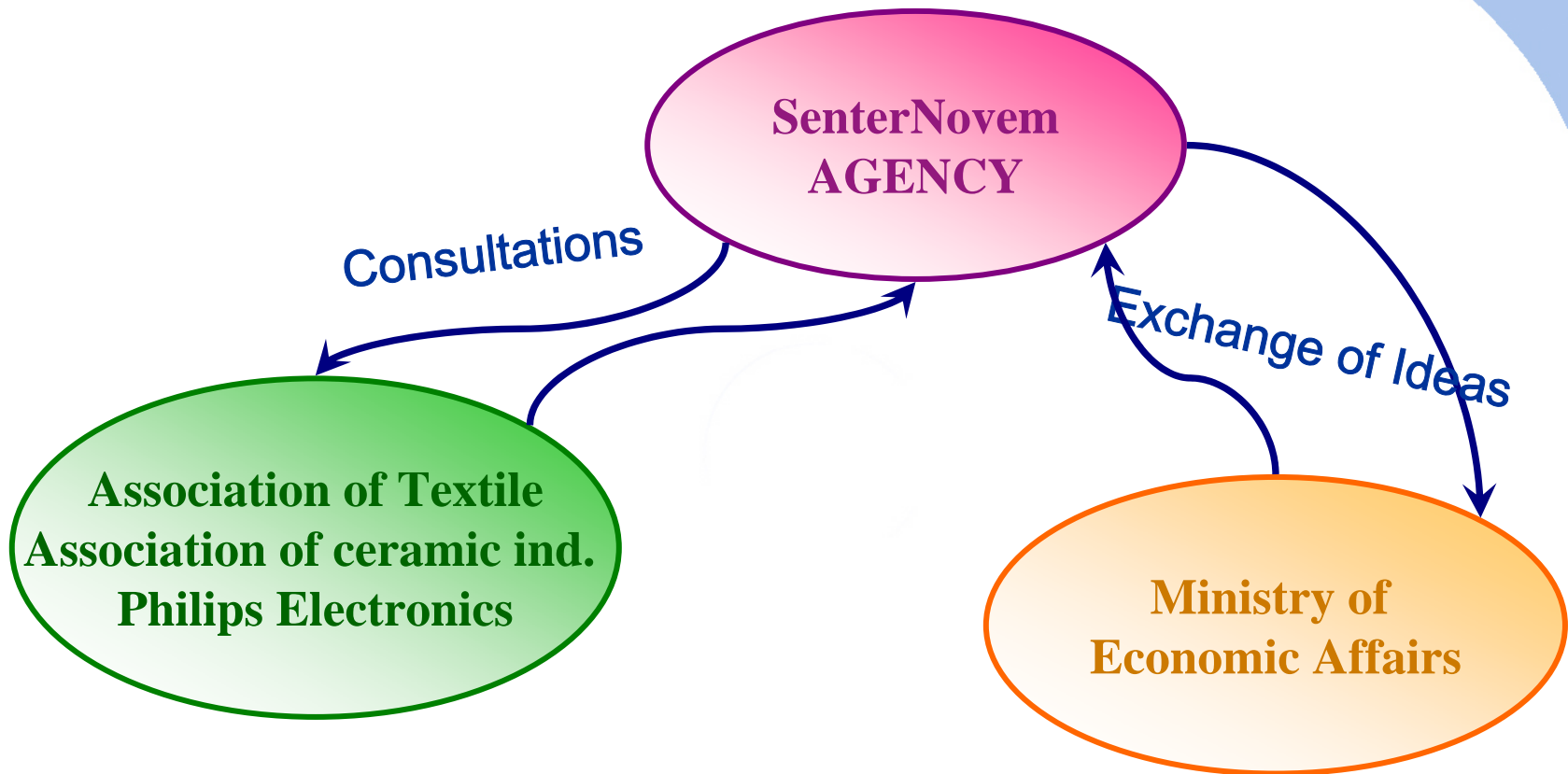

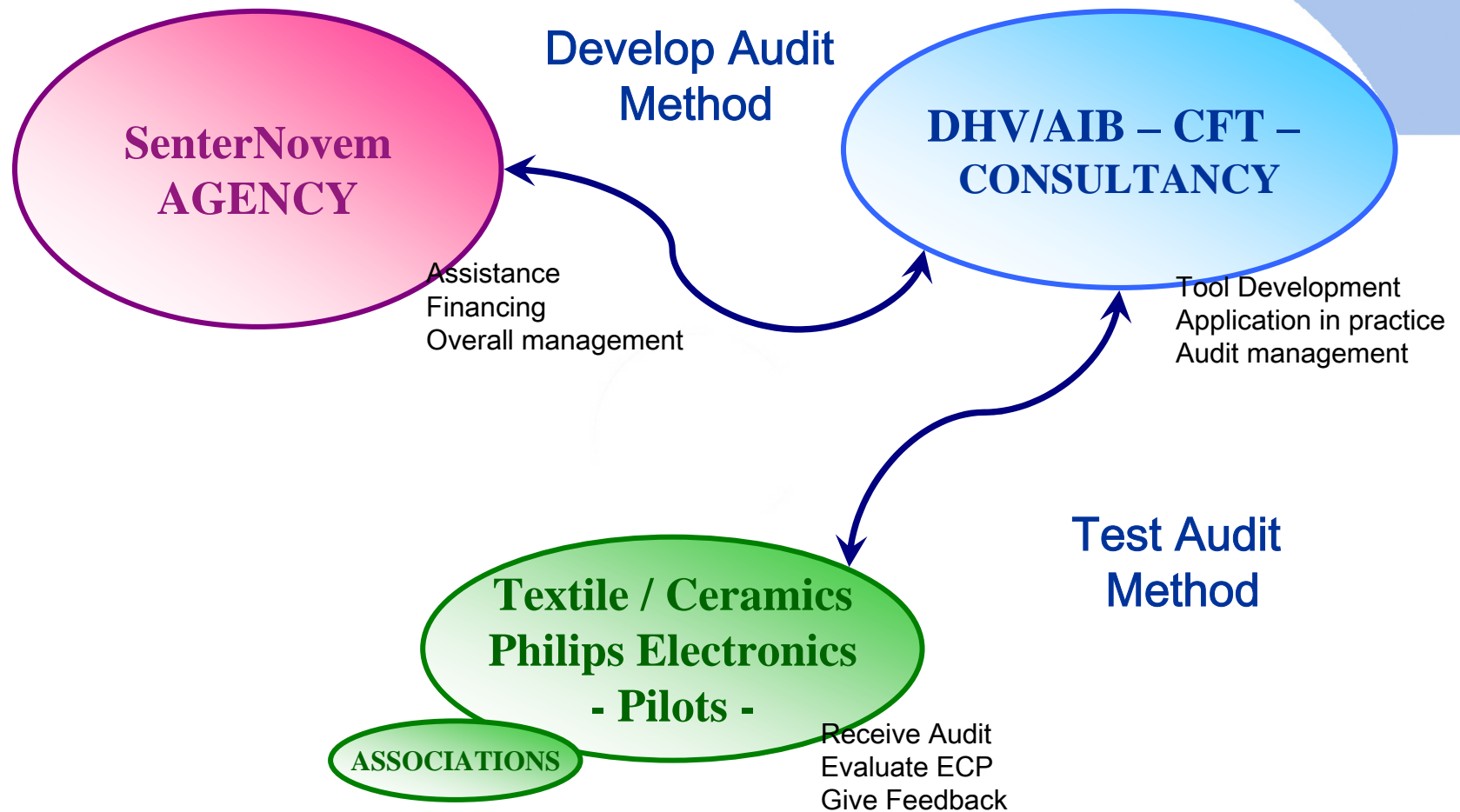
Phases in the overall organisation of the national audit process

- **IV - Follow up**

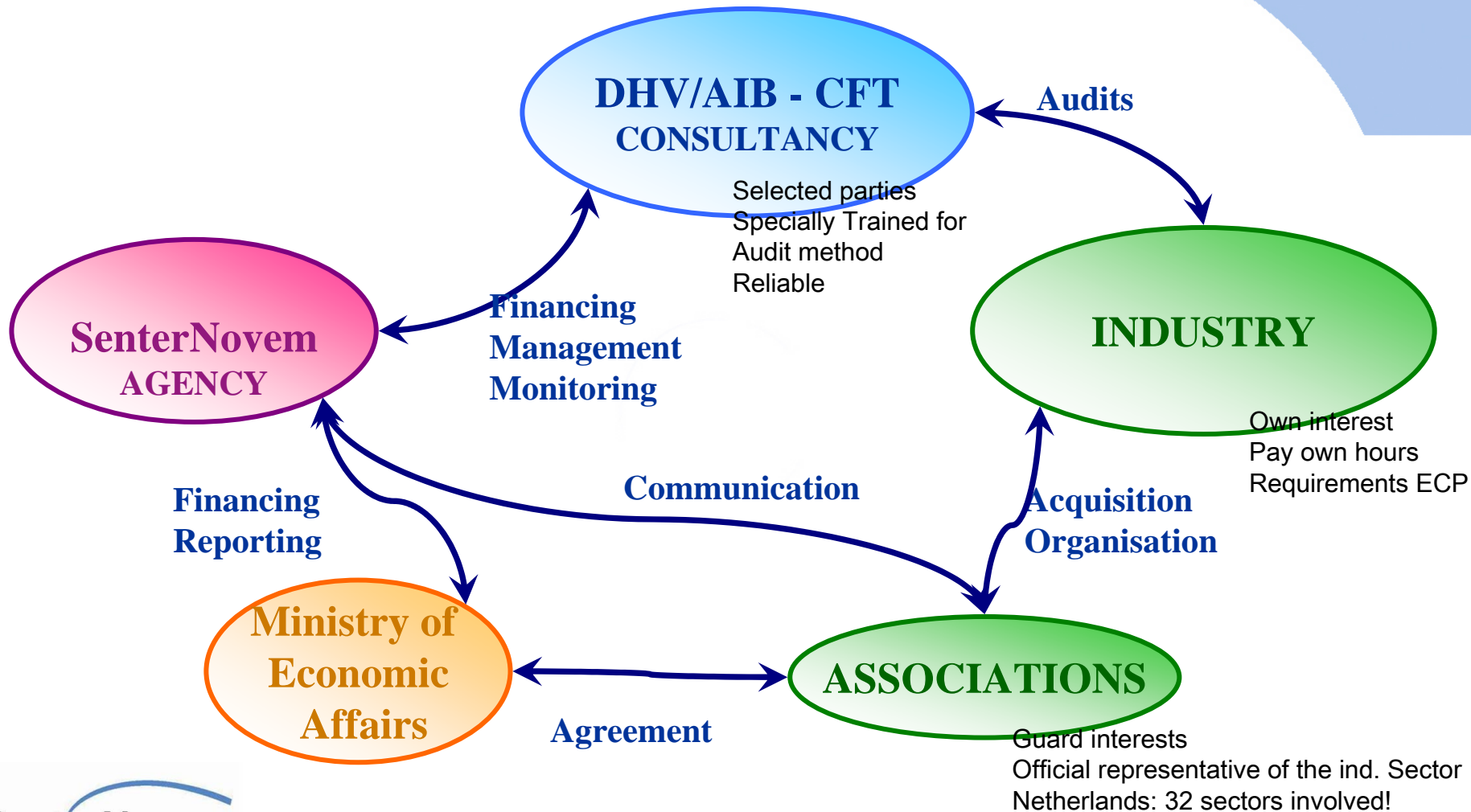
Phase I : Start up = communication



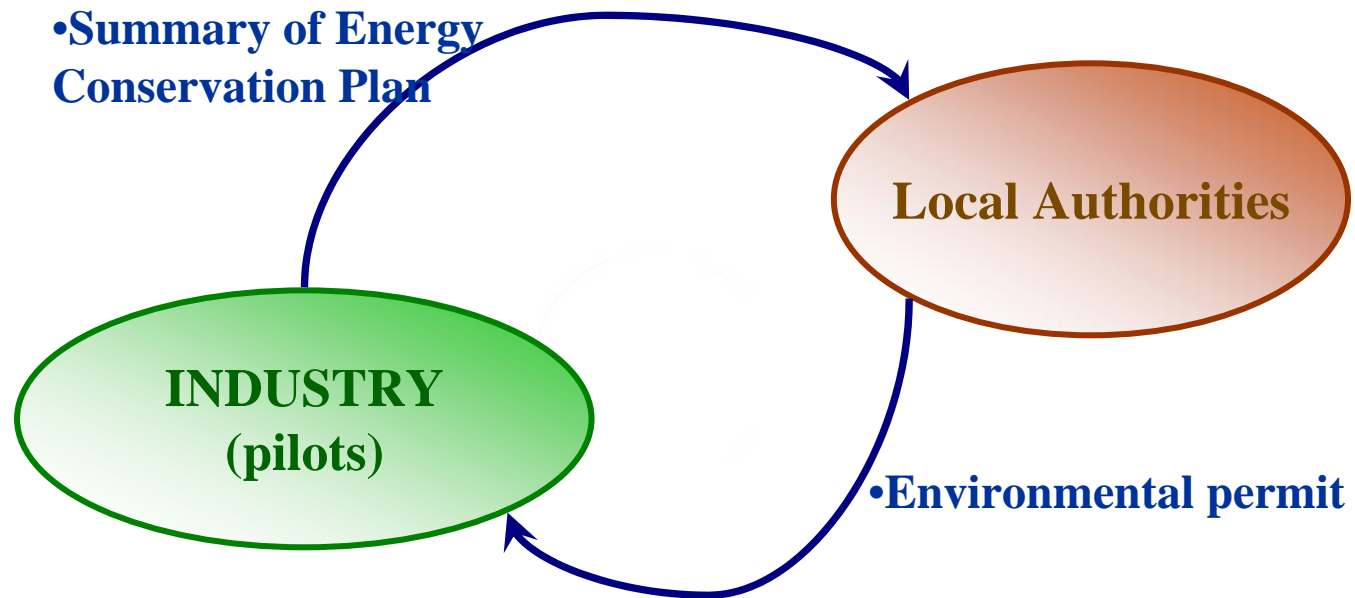
Phase II : Preparation = develop Audit method



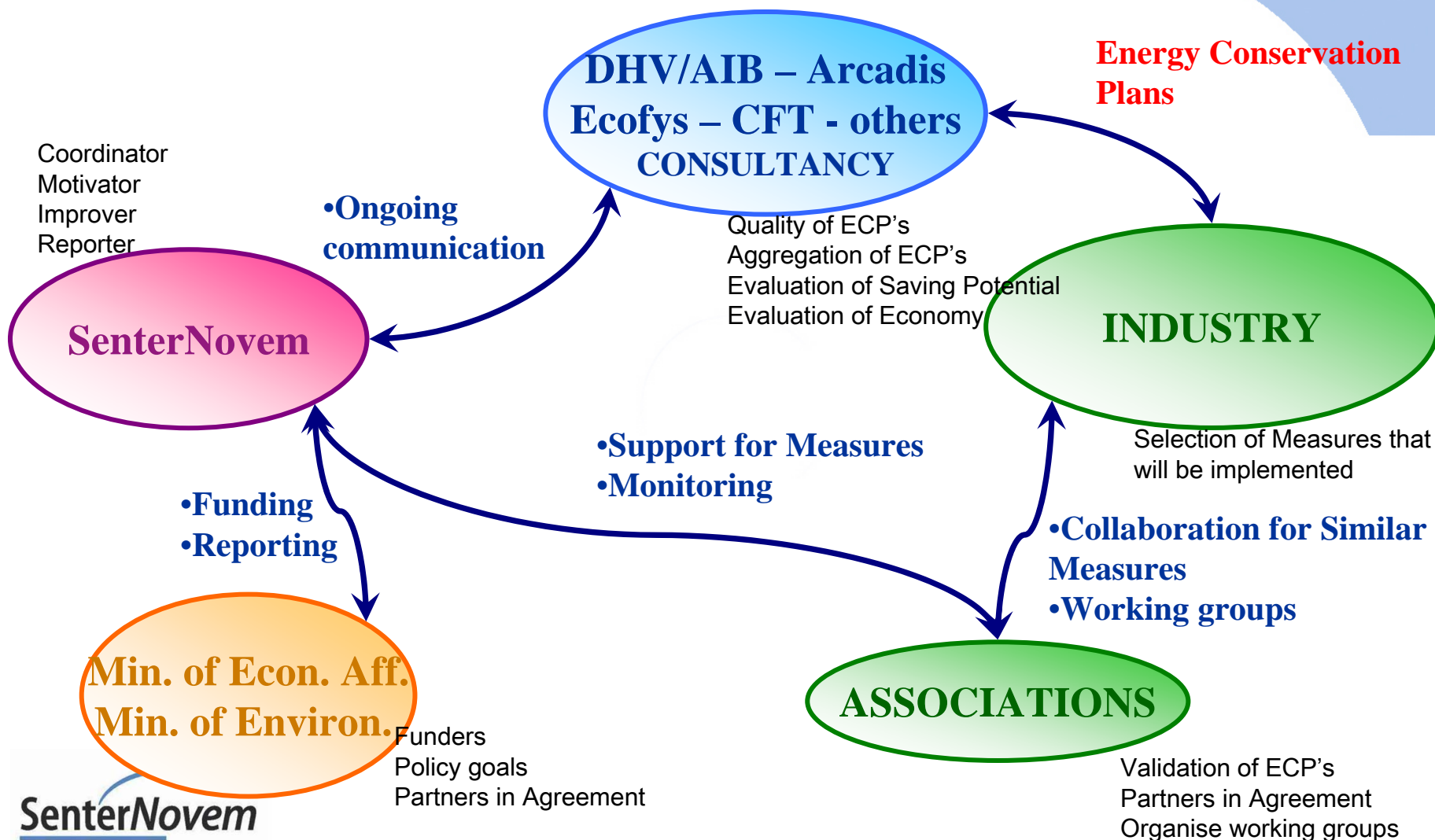
Phase III : Implementation = Large scale auditing
